Gen. 32:11 **Save** me, I pray, from the hand of my brother Esau, for I am afraid he will come and attack me, and also the mothers with their children.

Gen. 45:5 And now, do not be distressed and do not be angry with yourselves for selling me here, because it was to **save** lives that God sent me ahead of you.

Gen. 45:7 But God sent me ahead of you to preserve for you a remnant on earth and to **save** your lives by a great deliverance.

Gen. 47:25 “You have **saved** our lives,” they said. “May we find favor in the eyes of our lord; we will be in bondage to Pharaoh.”

Gen. 50:20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the **saving** of many lives.

Ex. 14:30 That day the LORD **saved** Israel from the hands of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians lying dead on the shore.

Ex. 15:2 The LORD is my strength and my song;
he has become my **salvation**.
He is my God, and I will praise him,
my father’s God, and I will exalt him.

Ex. 16:23-24 He said to them, “This is what the LORD commanded: ‘Tomorrow is to be a day of rest, a holy Sabbath to the LORD. So bake what you want to bake and boil what you want to boil. **Save** whatever is left and keep it until morning.’” So they **saved** it until morning, as Moses commanded, and it did not stink or get maggots in it.

Ex. 18:4 and the other was named Eliezer, for he said, “My father’s God was my helper; he **saved** me from the sword of Pharaoh.”

Ex. 18:8 Moses told his father-in-law about everything the LORD had done to Pharaoh and the Egyptians for Israel’s sake and about all the hardships they had met along the way and how the LORD had **saved** them.

Num. 31:18 but **save** for yourselves every girl who has never slept with a man.

Dt. 4:42 to which anyone who had killed a person could flee if he had unintentionally killed his neighbor without malice aforethought. He could flee into one of these cities and **save** his life.

Dt. 19:4-5 This is the rule concerning the man who kills another and flees there to **save** his life – one who kills his neighbor unintentionally, without malice aforethought. For instance, a man may go into the forest with his neighbor to cut wood, and as he swings his ax to fell a tree, the head may fly off and hit his neighbor and kill him. That man may flee to one of these cities and **save** his life.

- Dt. 32:15** Jeshurun grew fat and kicked;
filled with food, he became heavy and sleek.
He abandoned the God who made him
and rejected the Rock his **Savior**.
- Dt. 33:29** Blessed are you, O Israel!
Who is like you,
a people **saved** by the LORD?
He is your shield and helper
and your glorious sword.
Your enemies will cower before you,
and you will trample down their high places.”
- Jsh. 2:13** that you will spare the lives of my father and mother, my brothers and sisters,
and all who belong to them, and that you will **save** us from death.”
- Jsh. 9:26** So Joshua **saved** them from the Israelites, and they did not kill them.
- Jsh. 10:6** The Gibeonites then sent word to Joshua in the camp at Gilgal: “Do not
abandon your servants. Come up to us quickly and **save** us! Help us, because all
the Amorite kings from the hill country have joined forces against us.”
- Jdg. 2:16** Then the LORD raised up judges, who **saved** them out of the hands of these
raiders.
- Jdg. 2:18** Whenever the LORD raised up a judge for them, he was with the judge and
saved them out of the hands of their enemies as long as the judge lived; for the
LORD had compassion on them as they groaned under those who oppressed and
afflicted them.
- Jdg. 3:9** But when they cried out to the LORD, he raised up for them a deliverer,
Othniel son of Kenaz, Caleb’s younger brother, who **saved** them.
- Jdg. 3:31** After Ehud came Shamgar son of Anath, who struck down six hundred
Philistines with an oxgoad. He too **saved** Israel.
- Jdg. 6:14** The LORD turned to him and said, “Go in the strength you have and **save**
Israel out of Midian’s hand. Am I not sending you?”
- Jdg. 6:15** “But Lord,” Gideon asked, “how can I **save** Israel? My clan is the weakest in
Manasseh, and I am the least in my family.”
- Jdg. 6:31** But Joash replied to the hostile crowd around him, “Are you going to plead
Baal’s cause? Are you trying to **save** him? Whoever fights for him shall be put to
death by morning! If Baal really is a god, he can defend himself when someone
breaks down his altar.”
- Jdg. 6:36-37** Gideon said to God, “If you will **save** Israel by my hand as you have
promised – look, I will place a wool fleece on the threshing floor. If there is dew only
on the fleece and all the ground is dry, then I will know that you will **save** Israel by
my hand, as you said.”

- Jdg. 7:2** The LORD said to Gideon, "You have too many men for me to deliver Midian into their hands. In order that Israel may not boast against me that her own strength has **saved** her,
- Jdg. 7:7** The LORD said to Gideon, "With the three hundred men that lapped I will **save** you and give the Midianites into your hands. Let all the other men go, each to his own place."
- Jdg. 8:22** The Israelites said to Gideon, "Rule over us – you, your son and your grandson – because you have **saved** us out of the hand of Midian."
- Jdg. 10:1** After the time of Abimelech a man of Issachar, Tola son of Puah, the son of Dodo, rose to **save** Israel. He lived in Shamir, in the hill country of Ephraim.
- Jdg. 10:12-14** the Sidonians, the Amalekites and the Maonites oppressed you and you cried to me for help, did I not **save** you from their hands? But you have forsaken me and served other gods, so I will no longer **save** you. Go and cry out to the gods you have chosen. Let them **save** you when you are in trouble!"
- Jdg. 12:2** Jephthah answered, "I and my people were engaged in a great struggle with the Ammonites, and although I called, you didn't **save** me out of their hands.
- 1Sa. 4:3** When the soldiers returned to camp, the elders of Israel asked, "Why did the LORD bring defeat upon us today before the Philistines? Let us bring the ark of the LORD's covenant from Shiloh, so that it may go with us and **save** us from the hand of our enemies."
- 1Sa. 10:19** But you have now rejected your God, who **saves** you out of all your calamities and distresses. And you have said, 'No, set a king over us.' So now present yourselves before the LORD by your tribes and clans."
- 1Sa. 10:27** But some troublemakers said, "How can this fellow **save** us?" They despised him and brought him no gifts. But Saul kept silent.
- 1Sa. 14:6** Jonathan said to his young armor-bearer, "Come, let's go over to the outpost of those uncircumcised fellows. Perhaps the LORD will act in our behalf. Nothing can hinder the LORD from **saving**, whether by many or by few."
- 1Sa. 17:47** All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the LORD **saves**; for the battle is the LORD's, and he will give all of you into our hands."
- 1Sa. 23:2** he inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I go and attack these Philistines?" The LORD answered him, "Go, attack the Philistines and **save** Keilah."
- 1Sa. 23:5** So David and his men went to Keilah, fought the Philistines and carried off their livestock. He inflicted heavy losses on the Philistines and **saved** the people of Keilah.

but we gave birth to wind.
We have not brought **salvation** to the earth;
we have not given birth to people of the world.
- Is. 30:15 This is what the Sovereign LORD, the Holy One of Israel, says:
“In repentance and rest is your **salvation**,
in quietness and trust is your strength,
but you would have none of it.
- Is. 33:2 O LORD, be gracious to us;
we long for you.
Be our strength every morning,
our **salvation** in time of distress.

- Is. 33:6 He will be the sure foundation for your times,
a rich store of **salvation** and wisdom and knowledge;
the fear of the LORD is the key to this treasure.
- Is. 33:22 For the LORD is our judge,
the LORD is our lawgiver,
the LORD is our king;
it is he who will **save** us.
- Is. 35:4 say to those with fearful hearts,
“Be strong, do not fear;
your God will come,
he will come with vengeance;
with divine retribution
he will come to **save** you.”
- Is. 36:20 Who of all the gods of these countries has been able to **save** his land from
me? How then can the LORD deliver Jerusalem from my hand?”
- Is. 37:35 “I will defend this city and **save** it,

- Is. 38:20 The LORD will **save** me,
and we will sing with stringed instruments
all the days of our lives
in the temple of the LORD.
- Is. 43:3 For I am the LORD, your God,
the Holy One of Israel, your **Savior**;
I give Egypt for your ransom,
Cush and Seba in your stead.
- Is. 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD,
and apart from me there is no **savior**.
- Is. 43:12 I have revealed and **saved** and proclaimed –
I, and not some foreign god among you.
You are my witnesses,” declares the LORD, “that I am God.
- Is. 44:17 From the rest he makes a god, his idol;
he bows down to it and worships.
He prays to it and says,
“**Save** me; you are my god.”
- Is. 44:20 He feeds on ashes, a deluded heart misleads him;
he cannot **save** himself, or say,
“Is not this thing in my right hand a lie?”
- Is. 45:8 “You heavens above, rain down righteousness;
let the clouds shower it down.
Let the earth open wide,
let **salvation** spring up,

let righteousness grow with it;
I, the LORD, have created it.

Is. 45:15 Truly you are a God who hides himself,
O God and **Savior** of Israel.

Is. 45:17 But Israel will be **saved** by the LORD
with an everlasting **salvation**;
you will never be put to shame or disgraced,
to ages everlasting.

Is. 45:20 "Gather together and come;
assemble, you fugitives from the nations.
Ignorant are those who carry about idols of wood,
who pray to gods that cannot **save**.

Is. 45:21 Declare what is to be, present it –
let them take counsel together.
Who foretold this long ago,
who declared it from the distant past?
Was it not I, the LORD?
And there is no God apart from me,
a righteous God and a **Savior**;
there is none but me.

Is. 45:22 "Turn to me and be **saved**,
all you ends of the earth;

these you have labored with
and trafficked with since childhood.
Each of them goes on in his error;
there is not one that can **save** you.
- Is. 49:6 he says:

to restore the tribes of Jacob
and bring back those of Israel I have kept.
I will also make you a light for the Gentiles,
that you may bring my **salvation** to the ends of the earth.”
- Is. 49:8 This is what the LORD says:

and in the day of **salvation** I will help you;
I will keep you and will make you

But my **salvation** will last forever,

and mountains is a deception;
surely in the LORD our God
is the **salvation** of Israel.
- Jer. 4:14 O Jerusalem, wash the evil from your heart and be **saved**.
How long will you harbor wicked thoughts?

the summer has ended,
and we are not **saved**."

Ez. 18:27 But if a wicked man turns away from the wickedness he has committed and does what is just and right, he will **save** his life.

Ez. 33:5 Since he heard the sound of the trumpet but did not take warning, his blood will be on his own head. If he had taken warning, he would have **saved** himself.

Ac. 16:17 This girl followed Paul and the rest of us, shouting, “These men are servants of the Most High God, who are telling you the way to be **saved**.”

Ac. 16:30-31 He then brought them out and asked, “Sirs, what must I do to be **saved**?”
They replied, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be **saved** – you and your household.”

Ac. 27:20 When neither sun nor stars appeared for many days and the storm continued raging, we finally gave up all hope of being **saved**.

Ac. 27:31 Then Paul said to the centurion and the soldiers, "Unless these men stay with the ship, you cannot be **saved**."

Ac. 28:28 "Therefore I want you to know that God's **salvation** has been sent to the Gentiles, and they will listen!"

Ro. 1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the **salvation** of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.

Ro. 5:9-10 Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be **saved** from God's wrath through him! For if, when we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be **saved** through his life!

Ro. 8:24 For in this hope we were **saved**. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what he already has?

Ro. 9:27 Isaiah cries out concerning Israel:
"Though the number of the Israelites be like the sand by the sea,
only the remnant will be **saved**."

Ro. 10:1 Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be **saved**.

Ro. 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be **saved**. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are **saved**.

Ro. 10:13 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be **saved**."

Ro. 11:11 Again I ask: Did they stumble so as to fall beyond recovery? Not at all! Rather, because of their transgression, **salvation** has come to the Gentiles to make Israel envious.

Ro. 11:14 in the hope that I may somehow arouse my own people to envy and **save** some of them.

Ro. 11:26 And so all Israel will be **saved**, as it is written:
"The deliverer will come from Zion;
he will turn godlessness away from Jacob."

Ro. 13:11 And do this, understanding the present time. The hour has come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our **salvation** is nearer now than when we first believed.

1Co. 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being **saved** it is the power of God.

1Co. 1:21 For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to **save** those who believe.

- 1Co. 3:15** If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be **saved**, but only as one escaping through the flames.
- 1Co. 5:5** hand this man over to Satan, so that the sinful nature may be destroyed and his spirit **saved** on the day of the Lord.
- 1Co. 7:16** How do you know, wife, whether you will **save** your husband? Or, how do you know, husband, whether you will **save** your wife?
- 1Co. 9:22** To the weak I became weak, to win the weak. I have become all things to all men so that by all possible means I might **save** some.
- 1Co. 10:33** even as I try to please everybody in every way. For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be **saved**.
- 1Co. 15:2** By this gospel you are **saved**, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.
- 1Co. 16:2** On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, **saving** it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made.
- 2Co. 1:6** If we are distressed, it is for your comfort and **salvation**; if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which produces in you patient endurance of the same sufferings we suffer.
- 2Co. 2:15** For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being **saved** and those who are perishing.
- 2Co. 6:2** For he says,
"In the time of my favor I heard you,
and in the day of **salvation** I helped you."
I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of **salvation**.
- 2Co. 7:10** Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to **salvation** and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.
- 2Co. 12:14** Now I am ready to visit you for the third time, and I will not be a burden to you, because what I want is not your possessions but you. After all, children should not have to **save** up for their parents, but parents for their children.
- Eph. 1:13** And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your **salvation**. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,
- Eph. 2:5** made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions – it is by grace you have been **saved**.
- Eph. 2:8-9** For it is by grace you have been **saved**, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast.

Eph. 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the **Savior**.

Eph. 6:17 Take the helmet of **salvation** and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Pp. 1:28 without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be **saved** – and that by God.

Pp. 2:12 Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed – not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence – continue to work out your **salvation** with fear and trembling,

Pp. 3:20 But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a **Savior** from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,

1Th. 2:16 in their effort to keep us from speaking to the Gentiles so that they may be **saved**. In this way they always heap up their sins to the limit. The wrath of God has come upon them at last.

1Th. 5:8-9 But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of **salvation** as a helmet. For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive **salvation** through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2Th. 2:10 and in every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing. They perish because they refused to love the truth and so be **saved**.

2Th. 2:13 But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers loved by the Lord, because from the beginning God chose you to be **saved** through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.

1Ti. 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the command of God our **Savior** and of Christ Jesus our hope,

1Ti. 1:15 Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to **save** sinners – of whom I am the worst.

1Ti. 2:3-4 This is good, and pleases God our **Savior**, who wants all men to be **saved** and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

1Ti. 2:15 But women will be **saved** through childbearing – if they continue in faith, love and holiness with propriety.

1Ti. 4:10 (and for this we labor and strive), that we have put our hope in the living God, who is the **Savior** of all men, and especially of those who believe.

1Ti. 4:16 Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will **save** both yourself and your hearers.

2Ti. 1:9-10 who has **saved** us and called us to a holy life – not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, but it has now been revealed through the

appearing of our **Savior**, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

2Ti. 2:10 Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the **salvation** that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.

2Ti. 3:15 and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for **salvation** through faith in Christ Jesus.

Tit. 1:3-4 and at his appointed season he brought his word to light through the preaching entrusted to me by the command of God our **Savior**,
To Titus, my true son in our common faith:
Grace and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our **Savior**.

Tit. 2:10-11 and not to steal from them, but to show that they can be fully trusted, so that in every way they will make the teaching about God our **Savior** attractive.
For the grace of God that brings **salvation** has appeared to all men.

Tit. 2:13 while we wait for the blessed hope – the glorious appearing of our great God and **Savior**, Jesus Christ,

Tit. 3:4-6 But when the kindness and love of God our **Savior** appeared, he **saved** us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He **saved** us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our **Savior**,

Heb. 1:14 Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit **salvation**?

Heb. 2:3 how shall we escape if we ignore such a great **salvation**? This **salvation**, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him.

Heb. 2:10 In bringing many sons to glory, it was fitting that God, for whom and through whom everything exists, should make the author of their **salvation** perfect through suffering.

Heb. 5:7 During the days of Jesus' life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could **save** him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission.

Heb. 5:9 and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal **salvation** for all who obey him

Heb. 6:9 Even though we speak like this, dear friends, we are confident of better things in your case – things that accompany **salvation**.

Heb. 7:25 Therefore he is able to **save** completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

Heb. 9:28 so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring **salvation** to those who are waiting for him.

Heb. 10:39 But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who believe and are **saved**.

Heb. 11:7 By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to **save** his family. By his faith he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.

Jas. 1:21 Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can **save** you.

Jas. 2:14 What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith **save** him?

Jas. 4:12 There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the one who is able to **save** and destroy. But you – who are you to judge your neighbor?

Jas. 5:20 remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will **save** him from death and cover over a multitude of sins.

1Pt. 1:5 who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the **salvation** that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

1Pt. 1:9 for you are receiving the goal of your faith, the **salvation** of your souls.

1Pt. 1:10 Concerning this **salvation**, the prophets, who spoke of the grace that was to come to you, searched intently and with the greatest care,

1Pt. 2:2 Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your **salvation**,

1Pt. 3:20-22 who disobeyed long ago when God waited patiently in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. In it only a few people, eight in all, were **saved** through water, and this water symbolizes baptism that now **saves** you also – not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God. It **saves** you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

1Pt. 4:18 And,
“If it is hard for the righteous to be **saved**,
what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?”

2Pt. 1:1 Simon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ,
To those who through the righteousness of our God and **Savior** Jesus Christ have received a faith as precious as ours:

2Pt. 1:11 and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and **Savior** Jesus Christ.

2Pt. 2:20 If they have escaped the corruption of the world by knowing our Lord and **Savior** Jesus Christ and are again entangled in it and overcome, they are worse off at the end than they were at the beginning.

2Pt. 3:2 I want you to recall the words spoken in the past by the holy prophets and the command given by our Lord and **Savior** through your apostles.

2Pt. 3:15 Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means **salvation**, just as our dear brother Paul also wrote you with the wisdom that God gave him.

2Pt. 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and **Savior** Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen.

1Jn. 4:14 And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the **Savior** of the world.

Jde. 3 Dear friends, although I was very eager to write to you about the **salvation** we share, I felt I had to write and urge you to contend for the faith that was once for all entrusted to the saints.

Jde. 23 snatch others from the fire and **save** them; to others show mercy, mixed with fear – hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh.

Jde. 25 to the only God our **Savior** be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen.

Rev. 7:10 And they cried out in a loud voice:
“**Salvation** belongs to our God,

Rev. 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say:
