

## eternal / eternally / eternity (86)

- Gen. 21:33** Abraham planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba, and there he called upon the name of the LORD, the **Eternal** God.
- Dt. 33:27** The **eternal** God is your refuge,  
and underneath are the everlasting arms.  
He will drive out your enemy before you,  
saying, 'Destroy him!'
- 1Ki. 10:9** Praise be to the LORD your God, who has delighted in you and placed you on the throne of Israel. Because of the LORD's **eternal** love for Israel, he has made you king, to maintain justice and righteousness."
- Ps. 16:11** You have made known to me the path of life;  
you will fill me with joy in your presence,  
with **eternal** pleasures at your right hand.
- Ps. 21:6** Surely you have granted him **eternal** blessings  
and made him glad with the joy of your presence.
- Ps. 93:2** Your throne was established long ago;  
you are from all **eternity**.
- Ps. 111:10** The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom;  
all who follow his precepts have good understanding.  
To him belongs **eternal** praise.
- Ps. 119:89** Your word, O LORD, is **eternal**;  
it stands firm in the heavens.
- Ps. 119:160** All your words are true;  
all your righteous laws are **eternal**.
- Pr. 8:23** I was appointed from **eternity**,  
from the beginning, before the world began.
- Ecc. 3:11** He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set **eternity** in the hearts of men; yet they cannot fathom what God has done from beginning to end.
- Ecc. 12:5** when men are afraid of heights  
and of dangers in the streets;  
when the almond tree blossoms  
and the grasshopper drags himself along  
and desire no longer is stirred.  
Then man goes to his **eternal** home  
and mourners go about the streets.
- Is. 26:4** Trust in the LORD forever,  
for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock **eternal**.

- Is. 47:7** You said, 'I will continue forever –  
the **eternal** queen!  
But you did not consider these things  
or reflect on what might happen.
- Jer. 10:10** But the LORD is the true God;  
he is the living God, the **eternal** King.  
When he is angry, the earth trembles;  
the nations cannot endure his wrath.
- Dan. 4:3** How great are his signs,  
how mighty his wonders!  
His kingdom is an **eternal** kingdom;  
his dominion endures from generation to generation.
- Dan. 4:34** At the end of that time, I, Nebuchadnezzar, raised my eyes toward heaven,  
and my sanity was restored. Then I praised the Most High; I honored and glorified  
him who lives forever.  
  
His dominion is an **eternal** dominion;  
his kingdom endures from generation to generation.
- Hab. 3:6** He stood, and shook the earth;  
he looked, and made the nations tremble.  
The ancient mountains crumbled  
and the age-old hills collapsed.  
His ways are **eternal**.
- Mt. 18:8** If your hand or your foot causes you to sin cut it off and throw it away. It is  
better for you to enter life maimed or crippled than to have two hands or two feet  
and be thrown into **eternal** fire.
- Mt. 19:16** Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, "Teacher, what good thing must I  
do to get **eternal** life?"
- Mt. 19:29** And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother  
or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit  
**eternal** life.
- Mt. 25:41** "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed,  
into the **eternal** fire prepared for the devil and his angels.
- Mt. 25:46** "Then they will go away to **eternal** punishment, but the righteous to **eternal**  
life."
- Mk. 3:29** But whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; he is  
guilty of an **eternal** sin."
- Mk. 10:17** As Jesus started on his way, a man ran up to him and fell on his knees  
before him. "Good teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit **eternal** life?"

- Mk. 10:30** will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age (homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields – and with them, persecutions) and in the age to come, **eternal** life.
- Lk. 10:25** On one occasion an expert in the law stood up to test Jesus. “Teacher,” he asked, “what must I do to inherit **eternal** life?”
- Lk. 16:9** I tell you, use worldly wealth to gain friends for yourselves, so that when it is gone, you will be welcomed into **eternal** dwellings.
- Lk. 18:18** A certain ruler asked him, “Good teacher, what must I do to inherit **eternal** life?”
- Lk. 18:30** will fail to receive many times as much in this age and, in the age to come, **eternal** life.”
- Jn. 3:15** that everyone who believes in him may have **eternal** life.
- Jn. 3:16** “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have **eternal** life.
- Jn. 3:36** Whoever believes in the Son has **eternal** life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God’s wrath remains on him.”
- Jn. 4:14** but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to **eternal** life.”
- Jn. 4:36** Even now the reaper draws his wages, even now he harvests the crop for **eternal** life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together.
- Jn. 5:24** “I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has **eternal** life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.
- Jn. 5:39** You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess **eternal** life. These are the Scriptures that testify about me,
- Jn. 6:27** Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to **eternal** life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval.”
- Jn. 6:40** For my Father’s will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have **eternal** life, and I will raise him up at the last day.”
- Jn. 6:54** Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has **eternal** life, and I will raise him up at the last day.
- Jn. 6:68** Simon Peter answered him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of **eternal** life.
- Jn. 10:28** I give them **eternal** life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.

- Jn. 12:25** The man who loves his life will lose it, while the man who hates his life in this world will keep it for **eternal** life.
- Jn. 12:50** I know that his command leads to **eternal** life. So whatever I say is just what the Father has told me to say.”
- Jn. 17:2-3** For you granted him authority over all people that he might give **eternal** life to all those you have given him. Now this is **eternal** life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.
- Ac. 13:46** Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: “We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of **eternal** life, we now turn to the Gentiles.
- Ac. 13:48** When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for **eternal** life believed.
- Ro. 1:20** For since the creation of the world God’s invisible qualities – his **eternal** power and divine nature – have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.
- Ro. 2:7** To those who by persistence in doing good seek glory, honor and immortality, he will give **eternal** life.
- Ro. 5:21** so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring **eternal** life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Ro. 6:22-23** But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is **eternal** life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is **eternal** life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Ro. 16:26** but now revealed and made known through the prophetic writings by the command of the **eternal** God, so that all nations might believe and obey him –
- 2Co. 4:17** For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an **eternal** glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is **eternal**.
- 2Co. 5:1** Now we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an **eternal** house in heaven, not built by human hands.
- Gal. 1:8-9** But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let him be **eternally** condemned! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let him be **eternally** condemned!
- Gal. 6:8** The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap **eternal** life.
- Eph. 3:11** according to his **eternal** purpose which he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**2Th. 2:16** May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and by his grace gave us **eternal** encouragement and good hope,

**1Tim. 1:16-17** But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his unlimited patience as an example for those who would believe on him and receive **eternal** life. Now to the King **eternal**, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

**1Tim. 6:12** Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the **eternal** life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

**2Tim. 2:10** Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with **eternal** glory.

**Tit. 1:2** a faith and knowledge resting on the hope of **eternal** life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time,

**Tit. 3:7** so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of **eternal** life.

**Heb. 5:9** and, once made perfect, he became the source of **eternal** salvation for all who obey him

**Heb. 6:2** instruction about baptisms, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and **eternal** judgment.

**Heb. 9:12** He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained **eternal** redemption.

**Heb. 9:14** How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the **eternal** Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

**Heb. 9:15** For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised **eternal** inheritance – now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.

**Heb. 13:20** May the God of peace, who through the blood of the **eternal** covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep,

**1Pt. 5:10** And the God of all grace, who called you to his **eternal** glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.

**2Pt. 1:11** and you will receive a rich welcome into the **eternal** kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

**1Jn. 1:2** The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the **eternal** life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us.

**1Jn. 2:25** And this is what he promised us – even **eternal** life.

**1Jn. 3:15** Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has **eternal** life in him.

**1Jn. 5:11** And this is the testimony: God has given us **eternal** life, and this life is in his Son.

**1Jn. 5:13** I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have **eternal** life.

**1Jn. 5:20** We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true – even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and **eternal** life.

**Jude 7** In a similar way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding towns gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion. They serve as an example of those who suffer the punishment of **eternal** fire.

**Jude 21** Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to **eternal** life.

**Rev. 14:6** Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the **eternal** gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth – to every nation, tribe, language and people.
